**“THESE DAYS: A CONVERSATION WITH JACKSON BROWNE,”
A ONE-HOUR RADIO SPECIAL FEATURING AN IN-DEPTH NEW INTERVIEW,
PREMIERES THANKSGIVING WEEKEND AND AIRS
ON STATIONS NATIONWIDE IN DECEMBER**

**Program features tracks from the new live album *Jackson Browne – Solo Acoustic Vol. 1*
and includes a previously unavailable in-concert version of “The Rebel Jesus”**

Los Angeles, CA, November 18, 2005: “These Days: A Conversation With Jackson Browne,” an all-new one-hour radio special, is set to premiere over Thanksgiving weekend and will continue airing during the month of December on NPR, NonComm, AC, AAA and Classic Rock stations nationwide. Featuring an extensive interview with Jackson Browne conducted by 107.1 KGSR-FM/Austin Program Director and music journalist Jody Denberg, the program—recorded last month in Austin, TX—also features five songs from the just-released Inside Recordings live album Jackson Browne--Solo Acoustic Vol. 1 as well as a previously unavailable live version of Browne’s rare track “The Rebel Jesus.”

The flagship Classic Rock FM s WZLX/Boston, WCSX/Detroit, KIHT/St. Louis and WKLH/Milwaukee, as well as Boston’s AAA leader WXRV-FM, will debut “These Days: A Conversation With Jackson Browne” with broadcasts over the upcoming holiday weekend (check each individual station for airtimes). On December 1 and December 8, the Public Radio Satellite System will make this special available to all of the interconnected public radio stations nationally with a satellite feed scheduled for 2 PM/ET on both dates.

Additionally, over 200 stations across the country will be serviced with a CD pressing of the program the week of December 5; Andy Cahn of Cahn Media will handle Specialty Shows and AAA, AC and Classic Rock radio, with NPR, PBS and NonComm outlets overseen by Fred Migliore of FM Odyssey and Fast Forward Promotions. During his conversation with Denberg, Jackson Browne discusses topics including: his early days growing up in Los Angeles and his move to New York City as a teenager; his dual identities as a musician and activist; launching his own label, Inside Recordings; and future projects. The interview also touches on the ongoing relevance of the powerful anti-war song “Lives In The Balance,” the title track of Browne’s 1986 album, and in live form, the lead single from Jackson Browne—Solo Acoustic Vol. 1. Listened to in context with current events, and with the new accompanying animated editorial documentary video available

for viewing at jacksonbrowne.com, "*Lives In The Balance*" sounds as if it was written today. The radio special's other featured tracks include "*These Days*" and the "*The Birds Of St. Marks*," which made its recording debut on **Jackson Browne—Solo Acoustic Vol. 1.**

Released on **October 11, 2005**, **Jackson Browne—Solo Acoustic Vol. 1** was produced by **Jackson Browne** and **Paul Dieter** and features solo performances on guitar and piano with a track listing spanning **Browne's** career. It is **Browne's** first live release since 1977's multi-platinum classic **Running On Empty**. **Browne's** latest album also marks the first worldwide release on **Inside Recordings**, the independent label he founded in 1999. The label is distributed nationally by top independent music distributor **Alternative Distribution Alliance (ADA)**; **Angel/EMI Records** in Canada, the UK, South America, and European and Southeast Asia regions; **Sony Music** in Japan, and **Shock Records** in Australia and New Zealand. A very limited pressing of the album with the bonus cut "*The Rebel Jesus*" is available at **Best Buy** outlets through **December**, or until quantities run out.

Stating that "**Browne** is in fine voice," *Rolling Stone Magazine* wrote of the disc, "Culled from the best takes of three years' worth of concerts, **Solo Acoustic Vol. 1** finds **Jackson Browne** delivering tender takes from his deep catalog...**Browne's** strength has always been songwriting, and **Solo Acoustic** delivers those songs with no extra baggage." The U.K.'s *Mojo Magazine* wrote, "An intimate Greatest hits 'n' tales from recent solo gigs. In a still beautiful city-weary choirboy vox with disarming live banter, here's all the slipping dreams and empty beauty of Southern California life."

Jackson Browne--Solo Acoustic Vol. 1 is the first in what will be a series of live releases from **Browne** on **Inside Recordings**. **Jackson Browne** is currently at work on a studio album of new material slated for a late 2006 release, followed by **Solo Acoustic Vol. 2.**

On **December 15**, **Browne** will be honored as **The Surround Music Awards' "Artist Of The Year,"** an annual honor saluting a recording artist who has demonstrated outstanding achievement in the field of surround sound during the previous year. Additionally, the 2005 **DVDA 5.1** surround sound expanded CD/DVD reissue of **Running On Empty** is nominated in the awards categories "**Best Additional Features**" and "**Best Mix: Non Orchestral.**"
